

#7533 "A-I"

14-CT Cross stitch

Olympus #25 floss is 6 strands. In this kit, all stitches are 3 strands.

<Precautions> *Please be careful when handling the needle and make sure you have all kit listed before you start.

<Materials> *Olympus #25 embroidery floss, #3800-Olympus Aida cloth, Cross stitch needle and Instrucons. (No lining cloth and No frame)

<Finished size> 20cm X 20cm / 7.8" x 7.8"

<How to finish> *To finish, put a towel on the back of the work and iron it at medium temperature.

Note: To start stitching, fold the cloth in 4 and start from the center.

*This kit can also be finished on a Coaster.

<When making a coaster>

1: Cut the cloth.(14cm x 14cm / 5.5" x 5.5" each)

2:After the cutting cloth, Cross-stitch the pattern so that the pattern is in the center of the cloth, leaving a seam allowance of 2cm.

(Coaster finished size : 10cm x 10cm / 3.9" x 3.9")

3: Fold the seam allowance in three and sew.

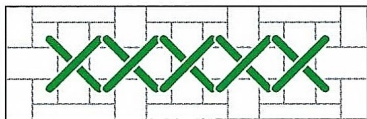
Note: For a coaster finish, cut the cloth in 4 and then cross-stitch. And at that time, 1 kind pattern is folded in 4, and stitch is START from the center.

How to stitch a cross-stitch クロス・ステッチの刺し方

Stitch so that the threads that cross over \times are always aligned in the same direction.

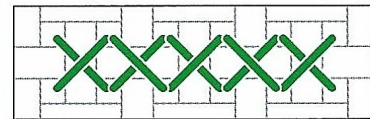
The threads that overlap on top are aligned.

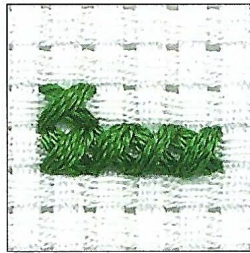
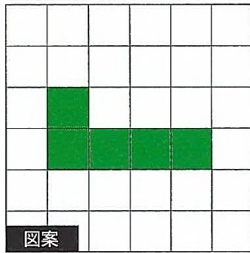


The directions of the threads that overlap on top are not aligned.

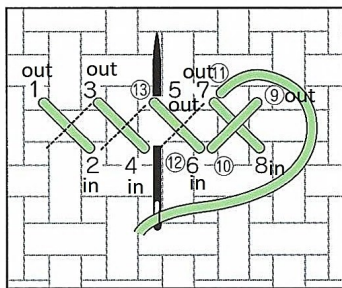
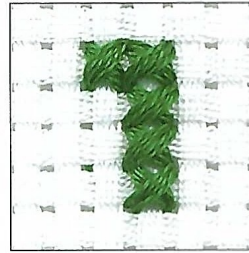
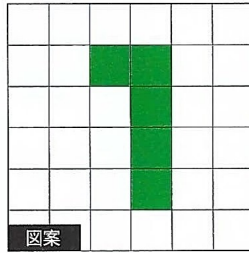

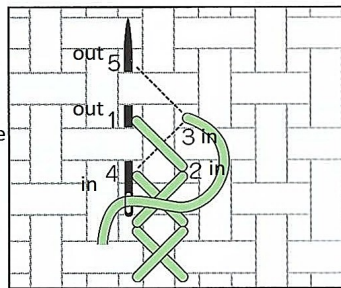
◆ When stitching sideways



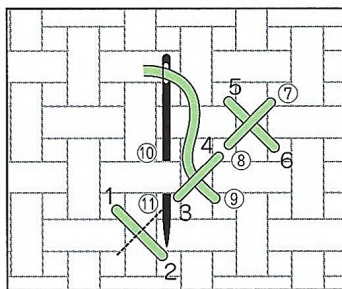
◆ When stitching vertically



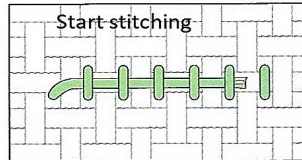
in: Insert the needle

◆ When stitching diagonally



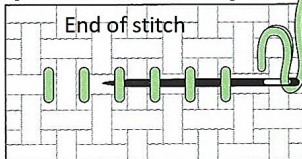
[Aida cloth / Back side]

the back side for Cross-stitching.

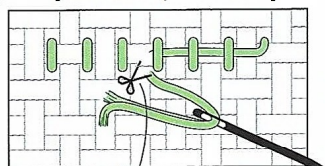
[Aida cloth / Back side]
