

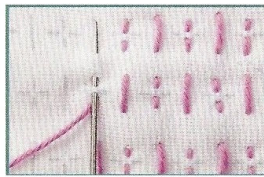
## Olympus Sashiko - Samplers (Traditional patterns - *Kuguri-sashi* )

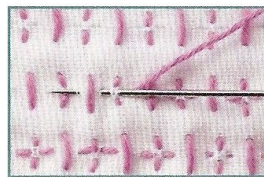
### "Kuguri-sashi"

"Kuguri-sashi" is one of Sashiko stitching techniques and very new to USA. Its stitching is completed by two steps - The first step is "Hitome-sashi" and the second step is "Weaving". That is, "Weaving" thread is woven under the threads of "Hitome-sashi" stitching by following the instructions. On the Olympus Sashiko sampler of "Kuguri-sashi", only the patterns for the first step ("Hitome-sashi") are pre-printed. "Kuguri-sashi" stitching creates Three-D feeling finish as well as beautiful and elegant patterns.

#### How to stitch "Kuguri-sashi"



Step 1 (1)  
Stitch on printed lines  
in vertical direction.

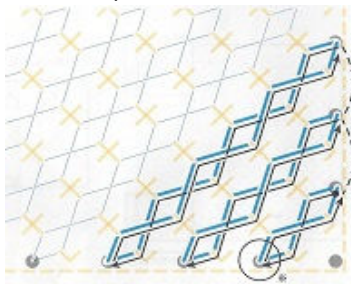


Step 1 (2)  
Stitch on printed lines  
in horizontal direction.



Step 2  
Weave a thread under the threads  
of "Hitome-sashi" stitching.

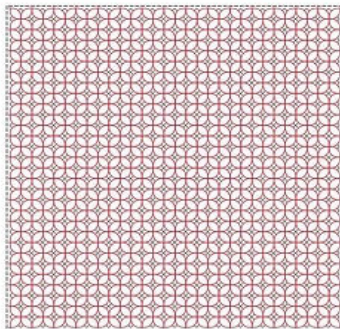
#### < Example of Instructions >



#### How to read the symbols on the instructions for weaving

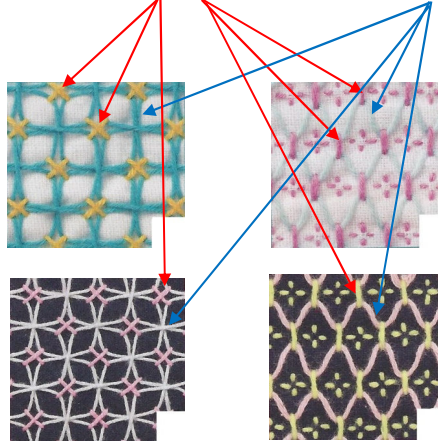
- Start point to weave (pre-printed on the cloth as well)
- Direction of movement
- Weaving thread
- End point to weave
- Needle through under the cloth

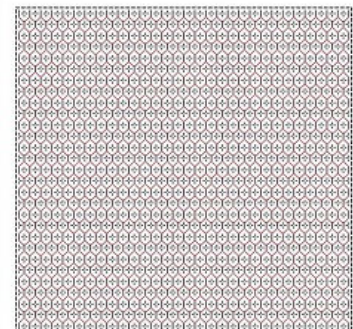
