

Dyeing with Three Colors of COLD DYE ALL Tie-Dye T-Shirt - swirl pattern -

COLD DYE ALL < 28 COLORS >

Dyeable of 20 T-shirts

The number may vary depending on how the dye is applied.



【What to prepare for dyeing one T-shirt】

COLD DYE ALL : 1 g × 3, Color Fixing agent : 6 mL, T-shirt × 1, Tray × 1, Net × 1, Containers for dissolving dye × 3, Rubber bands × 2, Boiling water: 50 mL × 3, Rubber gloves × 1, Container for soaping × 1, Mild detergent, Chopsticks or Spoons × 3

① Wash the T-shirt



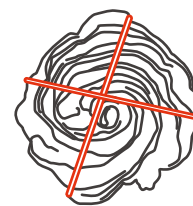
Wash off any dirt, stains, and starch, soak it in water for about 5 minutes, and then wring out the water thoroughly.

② Tying the T-shirt



Spread the T-shirt out on a flat surface like a table, where it's okay to get wet. Pinch the part you want to be the center of the swirl pattern, and roll it up while gathering the fabric in folds in a clockwise spiral.

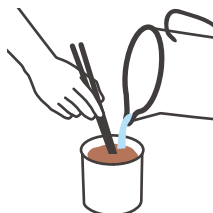
③ Secure with rubber bands



Once you've finished rolling the T-shirt, secure it with two rubber bands crossed over each other to keep it from losing its shape.

**Using three rubber bands will create a finer spiral pattern.*

④ Dissolve the dye



Place 1 g of dye into a container, add 50 mL of boiling water, and stir thoroughly with chopsticks or spoons until no granules remain. Prepare the dye liquor for each color in the same way.

⑤ Dyeing



Place a net on top of the tray and lay the T-shirt on it. Pour the dye liquor over the T-shirt, making sure that the same colors do not end up next to each other. Once the front side is dyed, turn the T-shirt inside out and pour the dye liquor over it so that the same colors appear in the same places as on the front. After dyeing both sides, let it sit for at least 20 minutes.

⑥ Soaping



After 20 minutes, remove the rubber band and rinse under running water. Once you've washed away the excess dye, add mild detergent, and while running water over the fabric, stir the fabric until the water runs clear. Then, soak the T-shirt in a 3 L of water with 6 mL of color fixing agent for 20 minutes to set the color.

**Stir occasionally.*

⑦ Air-dry in the shade



Air-dry in the shade, and once dry, it's ready.

**Please avoid washing dyed items together with other clothing.*
