

KOGIN 52 POUCH (Pink)

-Material:

- Cloth/#1100 Olympus Congress(Beige) for Kogin ---Size Approx. 31cm x 12cm
 Color cloth (Pink)---Size Approx. 31cm x 18cm
 Lining cloth(Ivory)---Size Approx.31cm x 21cm
- Thread/Kogin thread(#144 Pink) --- 1 skein
- Zipper 1 piece
- Needle/Kogin needle --- 1 piece

*Please note that the cloth or thread may transfer color if left in a strong rubbing or wet place.



刺しはじめる前に Before you start "How to handle Kogin thread"


Olympus Kogin thread has a simple texture.

The length of Kogin thread is 18m.
 The one skein is set in a long bundle.
 If you first fold the part tied with a string and cut the lower part, it will be about 1m each.




(Note: All stitches are 6 strands in this kit)

Olympus Kogin thread is made by 6 thin threads, which is a conbination of 2 threads.
 To make the thread bulge, pull it out one by one, loosen it, re-align the required number of threads, and then used it for a beautiful finish.



How to read and stitch the symbol diagram



[Cloth/Front side]

1 square of the daigram, corresponds 1 hole in the cloth.





When stitching to the right,

①out ②in ③out ④in

When stitching to the left, 5out 6in 7out 8in




At the turn of the row, slacken the thread from 0.2cm to 0.3cm and fold it back.

End of thread

[Cloth/Back side] Cut

Scoop 2 to 3 stitches back so that the thread does not come out on the front side, and cut the thread.

The beginning of the stitch and when connecting threads.




It is better not to make a knot.
Start stitching, leaving 4 cm to 5 cm of thread end.
Stitch from Light to Left according to the design.

After stitching to the end, process the "End of thread" in figure.


Tips for Kogin-zashi (stitch)

- O Pull out the needle after each stitch and stitch the same pull.
- O Do not pull the thread too hard.
- If you make a mistake in stitching, pull out the thread one by one with the head of needle and re-stitch it.
- O Do not entangle the thread left at the beginning of the stitch.
- When the thread is twisted, turn the needle in the opposite direction of the twist and stitch while untwisting.


Pouch: Finished size / about H12cm x W18cm x T3cm




(2) Sew the kogin-stitch Congress cloth and the pink cloth are sewn together on the front side(right side), as shown in the figure and divide the seam allowance. Front sides




(3) Fold the Pink cloth explained in 2 as shown in figure 1.5cm < 折り線で折る




Align the front sides together as shown in Figure 4 and fold in half. And then sew thesewing lines.




Cut the lining cloth to the figure shown on the left. Fold it in half with front sides facing and sew the sewing line. Fold it outside as shown on the right figure to shape it.





Turn the front cloths explained in 5 upside down, put the lining cloth inside, and sew the zipper.



8 Adjust the shape








◆ Leave 15cm thread on the back side.

Use it on the right side.



First, Kogin stitch the upper half.

<Start 1st row> Left side

Leave 15cm of thread at the beginning of the stitch and stitch to the left.

Start with the mark ● in the middle of the figure "Position to start stitching".

When you come to the left end, scoop 2 to 3 stitches back. Reference "How to end of thread" <1st row> Right side

Use the 15cm thread left first. And go to the right end. And move the 2nd row.

<2nd row> Go from right to left end.

<3rd row> Go from left to right end. If you feel it is difficult from left to right of stitch, you could rotate the cloth and pattern to stitch.

Then repeat in the same way. This would be the end of upper half side.

*Tip: When starting the bottom half side, it would be easier to stitch by rotating the cloth and pattern.

<Stitch the bottom half>

Stitch to the left, leaving 15cm of thread in the middle, as in the upper half side. After stitching to the left end, process the thread and cut the thread.


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Pouch Pattern
