## Kogin-zashi Coaster A

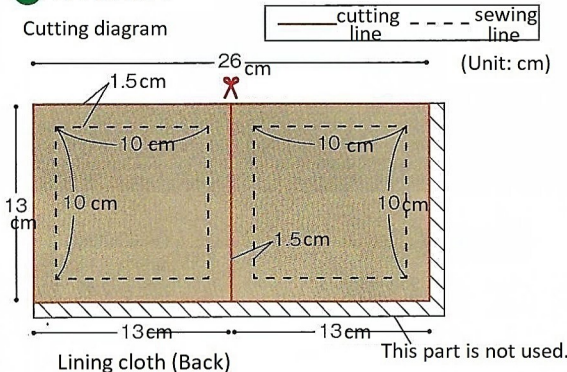
### Materials

- Olympus Kogin thread 100% Cotton  
#166, #194, #218, & #255 x 2 pieces each, #224, #766 x 1 piece each
- Olympus Congress Mustard & White 15cm X 15cm each
- Cloth for Lining (45 % Cotton, 56% Linen)
- 1 Kogin needle

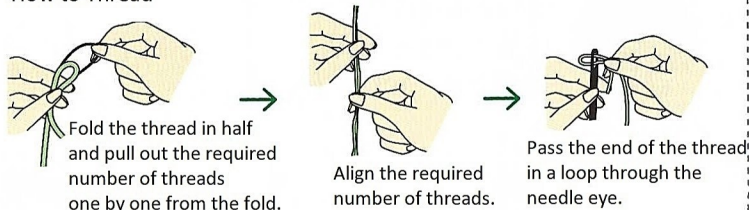
### Cloth Cut



### How to handle Kogin thread

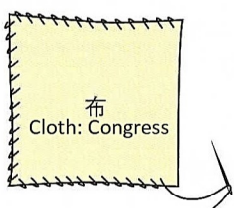
Olympus Kogin-thread is attractive for its matte and simple texture.  
Handle it carefully and gently so as not to damage the thread.  
(All stitches are 6 strands in this kit)

### How to Thread

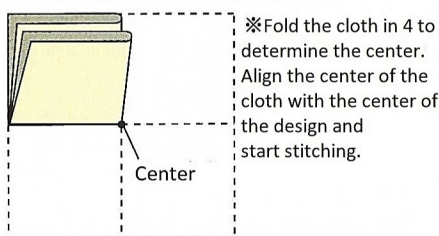


※ Olympus Kogin-thread is made by twisting 6 thin threads, which is a combination of 2 threads.  
To make the thread bulge, pull it out one by one, loosen it, re-align the required number of threads, and then used it for a beautiful finish.

### Bend the edge



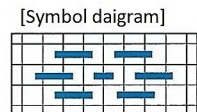
### Determine the position of the center of the cloth

### How to read and stitch the symbol diagram

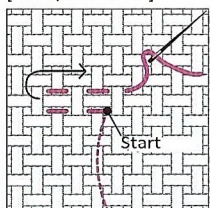


※ 1 square of the daigram, 1 stitch x 1 stitch on the cloth.

### Start to stitch

(All stitches are 6 strands)

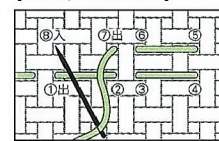
[Cloth/Front side]



① It is better not to make a knot. Start stitching, leaving 4cm to 5cm of the thread end.  
Stitch from light to left according to the design.  
After stitching to the end, process the "End of thread" in figure.

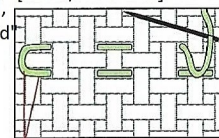
### Stitch Order

[Cloth/Front side]



<Right to left>  
1 out, 2 in, 3 out  
4, in....  
<Left to right>  
5 out, 6 in, 7 out,  
8 in

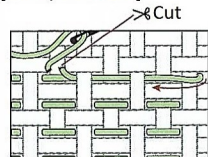
[Cloth/Back side]



At the turn of the next row, slacken the thread from 0.2cm to 0.3cm and fold it back.

### End of thread

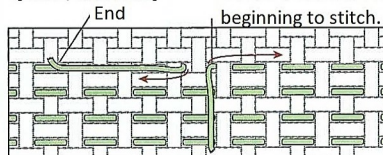
[Cloth/Back side]



Scoop 2 to 3 stitches back so that the thread does not come out on the front side, and cut the thread.

### The beginning of the stitch and when connecting threads

[Cloth/Back side]



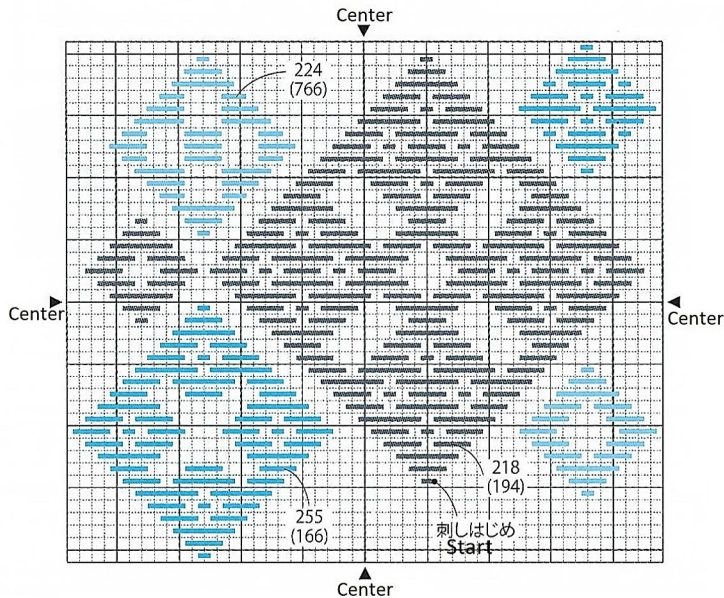
Leave 4 cm to 5 cm thread at the beginning to stitch.  
It is better not to knot.  
Start stitching, leaving 4 cm to 5 cm of thread end.  
Stitch from Light to Left according to the design.  
After stitching to the end, process the remaining thread end.

### Tips for Kogin-zashi(stitch)

- Pull out the needle after each stitch and stitch the same pull.
- Do not pull the thread too hard.
- If you make a mistake in stitching, pull out the thread one by one with the head of needle and re-stitch it.
- Do not entangle the thread left at the beginning of the stitch.
- When the thread is twisted, turn the needle in the opposite direction of the twist and stitch while untwisting.

※ The pattern is not full size.



All stitches are 6 strands!

Congress : Mustard

Congress : White

Finished size of Kogin design

Approximately 6cm X 6.9cm

How to see the number of thread

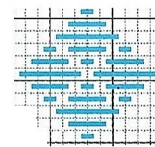
Example

224, 255, & 218 are for Mustard-colored cloth  
 (766, 166, & 194) are for White-colored cloth

The Olympus congress cloth used is

18-CT, 70 st / 10 cm square

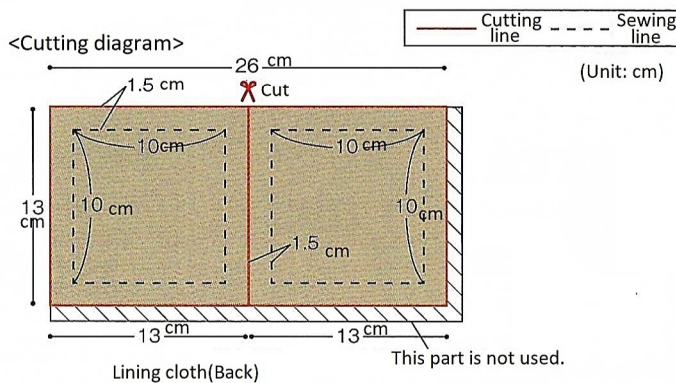
How to make a coaster

仕立て方

Coaster

Finished size : Approximately 6cm X 6.9cm

1. Refer to the cutting diagram and mark the Lining with a cut line and a sewing line and cut.



2. Align the Kogin stitch Congress and lining cloth with the inside and outside, and sew them together as shown in the figure, leaving 6 cm of the return opening.
